On March 24, 2019, I was dispatched to a child abuse call, the reporting party was not in Nye County so the call was handled by phone call.

I made contact with the reporting party who identified himself as . advised he picked from Angela Reinold at approximately 1700 hours. advised told him that his mom had spanked him with a clothes hanger, and there was a mark on the back of his leg. advised Angela told him she "tapped" him on the butt for acting out.

Furthermore, advised they have been in and out of court for the past year over child abuse issues.

advised he contacted Henderson Police Department to report that alleged child abuse. was advised since the abuse happed in Nye County, it would have to be reported in Nye County.

I made contact with Henderson Police Officer Wui #2406 who advised his supervisor told him to provide the event number #190324000649., and refer them to Nye County. I requested to speak with the Patrol Sgt to have a courtesy report completed.

I was able to make contact with the Patrol Sgt, he advised they would go back to the residence and generate a case number and investigation. The Patrol Sgt advised the report would be forwarded to me once it was completed and sent to the records department.

I requested a call for service to be generated and welfare check on the children at the mothers residence. See Deputy Williams supplemental report.

As of April 15, 2019, I have not received the report from the Henderson Police Department. Once I receive the report, any further investigation will be added via supplemental report. Additionally, I will add the involvements when I have confirmed names from the Henderson report.

On 03/25/2019 at approximately 0800 hours I was dispatched to the location of 1260 Bourbon street apartment 1, for a welfare check on juvenile children living within the residence.

Upon arrival I spoke with the mother Angela about the need to do a welfare check on her children. She allowed within the residence without question and allowed me to speak with her two children that were home. One juvenile is a male approximately 2 years old and the other is a female approximately 7 years old. Both juveniles were smiling and joking with me while on scene. The female is one year ahead in school as she is now in 4th grade instead of 3rd. I did not see any signs of abuse or neglect as both juveniles were eating breakfast getting ready for the day.

The house appeared to be neat and clean downstairs, I did not check the upstairs due to the fact I did not see signs of abuse neglect upon the children .

On July 28, 2020, I contacted the Henderson Police Department requesting the report they had generated in reference to the case.

I spoke with Patricia Kolbe of the records division, she advised me she would email a copy of the report to my county email. I received a copy at 1651 hours, on July 28, 2020, included was the incident report and John's written statement.

In Officer Wiu's report, he stated he took digital photographs of the injury and uploaded it into their digital evidence. These photographs were not included in the email I received from Patricia.

On August 8, 2020 at approximately 1314 hours, I received a response from The Henderson Police Department Records in regards to the digital photographs.

Patricia Kolbe responded "Please refer to the how to ordering for photos/videos." Patricia attached a word document on how to complete the request.

I completed the public records request and was provided case number 20-551517 and I will receive a response to the request within seven (7) days.

At approximately 1735 hours, I attempted to contact John two (2) times via 775-253-1735 with no answer and the voicemail was full.

I Detective Robert Perry was assigned case 19NY-0940, the case pertains to possible child abuse involving two victims. The victim's names are John Reinold-Sorget (DOB) and Savannah Reinold (DOB), the suspect is there mother by the name of Angela Reinold. The Father John Sorget Sr. and Angela are no longer married and at this time and are sharing custody of the children. originally made a report on March 25, 2019 and there has not been a forensic interview conducted until August 8, 2020 at No To Abuse in Pahrump, NV county of Nye with Emily Smith conducting the interview During the forensic interviews the following questions or statements were made by Savannah Reinold

The interview was concluded, Savannah did not disclose that she observed Angela striking John or her other siblings with a hanger or any other object. She did state that she thought her mother may have had anger issues in the past during the same time frame John was going through a hitting, kicking, yelling, throwing thing, and braking thing stage. Savannah said there was bruises but she did not know how her other siblings received them other than falling.

On August 20, 2020 a forensic interview was conducted at the CAC in Pahrump, Nv county of Nye with the victim John Reinold-Sorget Jr. During the interview John answered the following questions or made the following statements.

The interview was concluded with no disclosure other than the mother and father spans him on his butt using their hand. Throughout the interview John was not able to focus on the questions and distracted by other things in the room. On August 29, 2020 John Sorget Sr. sent me Comprehensive Psychological Assessment's from Restorative Behavioral Health LLC involving Savannah and John Jr. The assessments were conducted on March 31, 2019 and below are paragraphs I have copy and pasted from the assessments.
